




Α	AGE, SEX, NAME, D.O.B. Age and sex of casualty (demographic)
Т	TIME OF INCIDENT AND ESTIMATED TIME OF ARRIVAL Plus the time of incident
Μ	<ul> <li>MECHANISM OF INJURY</li> <li>This should include:</li> <li>The gross mechanism of injury (e.g., motor vehicle accident or stab wound to the chest) and</li> <li>Details of other factors known to be associated with major injury e.g., entrapment, vehicle rollover, occupant ejected from vehicle</li> </ul>
I	INJURIES SUSTAINED Seen or suspected
S	<ul> <li>SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS</li> <li>Vital signs including heart rate, blood pressure, respiratory rate, oxygen saturation and Glasgow Coma Score</li> <li>An indication as to whether the physiological state of the patient has improved or deteriorated since first seen</li> </ul>
